Teacher Training & French Language Course: INSTITUT LINGUISTIQUE ADENET

Notre Cours Standard de français pour les adultes intègre l'apprentissage du français général dans une méthode communicative. En complément, le Cours de Formation en enseignement (en mini-groupe de 3 personnes maximum) met à jour les connaissances dans le domaine de la didactique et de la pédagogie du FLE. L'immersion linguistique approfondit également les connaissances culturelles qui sont indispensables pour un enseignement optimal.

Teacher candidates specializing in French or completing a teachable in French are invited to apply.

Participation at the ILA will provide the opportunity to further develop French teaching skills, learn about international language acquisition teaching approaches, and experience an authentic French immersion environment. Teacher candidates will be able to collaborate with educators on strategies used in France and to practice their second language skills by living in a French setting.

The ILA:

- Offers various options for accommodations
- Provides courses with institute instructors
- Arranges cultural activities

Teacher Candidates are expected to:

- Cover expenses for transportation to/from ILA
- Register through the ILA website after receiving AFE approval (approx. 1200€)
- Pay for ILA accommodations (450 – 650€)

The ILA may host 5-8 Teacher Candidates.

Participants are eligible to apply for the Global Opportunities Award (\$1000 to recipients)
